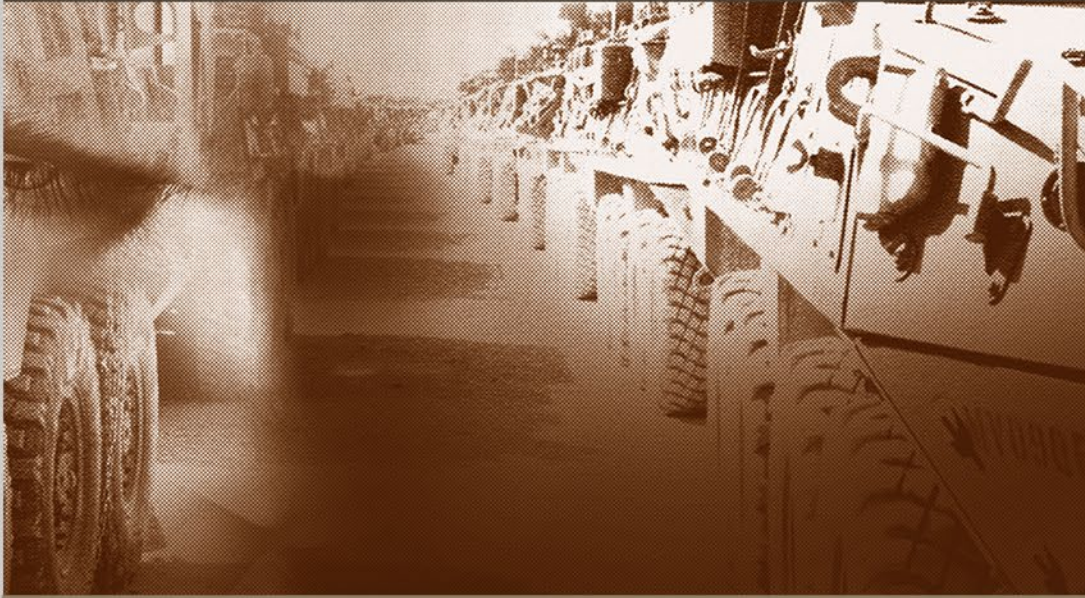

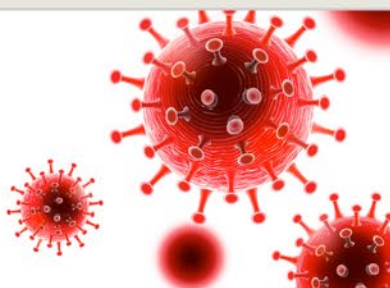

PMV-2

A Sergeant First Class assigned to Lens, Belgium, died in a PMV-2 mishap when he lost control of his motorcycle, hit a curb and was ejected into the wall of a nearby house. Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe International Military Police responded to the scene and identified the Soldier from his passport, which was on his person.

Motorcycles don't care how old you are, your experience level or how many training courses you have taken. They do what you tell them to do. If you drive too fast, small things like a curb may be the last thing you ever see.
