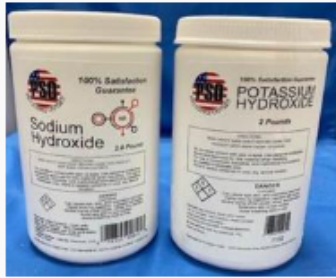

**Remedy:**

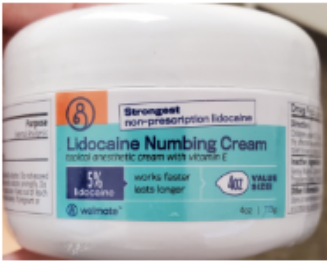
